




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"Our history dates back to the early twentieth century. The grandparents Paulino Lopez and Kiko Lopez, both wine growers, suffered the phylloxera plague. Grandfather Kiko said that after the loss of the vineyards, he planted his first vineyard in 1919 with American rootstocks. Our oldest vineyard today is the Garnacha. Our grandparents cultivated with the aim of making the best possible wine with manual techniques. In the decade of the 60s, everything changed and they stopped making wine. Our vineyards are located north of Toledo, influenced by the Sierra de Gredos, between the Alberche and Guadarrama rivers at an average altitude of 670 meters. Continental climate dominates with low rainfall and deep soils.
