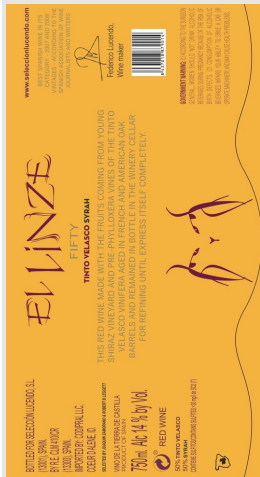

Vinification	Hand-harvested grapes. Pre-fermentation maceration at 14 deg C for 36 hours. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks at 26 deg C for 14 days with the grape skins.
Soil	Deep, rocky and limestone-rich clay soils.
Density	Syrah: 7,200 kg/ha / 30 year old vines Tinto Velasco: 140 year old pre-phyloxera vines

It was the year 1919 when D. César Lucendo Asensi opened a winery in Argamasilla de Alba (Ciudad Real). Generation after generation has followed the founder's tradition, adapting the family legacy to the new times to create unique wines. Jesús Lucendo grandson of César, is one of the greatest references in Enology in Castilla-La Mancha, directed several important national wineries and worked teaching Enology for decades. Currently, the fourth generation of the family is formed by Rafael and Federico, two young winemakers sons of Jesús, who are highly rewarded and considered in the world of Spanish wine.

In love with old and forgotten terroirs, where human intervention is hardly necessary, with a clear philosophy of orienting the cultivation of the vine to the ecological. They focus all their knowledge on trying to extract the maximum potential of the terroir, respecting the grape in the processes of elaboration and aging.

Tasting Notes

Beautiful and intense red cherry color with violet tones. Very complex and persistent on the nose, ripeness stands with aromas of black fruit, torrefacto, vanilla and pepper spices, oak and aromatic herbs (sandalwood) and mineral notes. Powerful to the taste with perfectly integrated tannins. Cocoa and menthol flavors with long and pleasant finish.
